The Board of Regents met at their Office at 3 o'clock P.M.,

Tuesday, June 2, 1902, a full Board being present.

Minutes of January 9 and March 8, 1902 read and approved.

On motion of Regent Deal, seconded by another Regent, the resignation of Mrs. Mary W. Emery was accepted to take effect August 31, 1902, and that Mrs. Emery be elected Professor Emeritus without salary, and the Secretary of the Board was instructed to inform Mrs. Emery and to write her a letter in recognition of her faithful services to the University and the cause of education.
