The Board of Regents met at 10 o'clock A.M., Saturday, December 6, 1902. Present W. E. F. Deal, J. N. Evans and W. W. Booher.

President Stubbs presented and read his report for 1901-02, which was adopted, and Regent Deal was requested to prepare the report for the Board of Regents to the Governor.

On motion of Regent Deal, seconded by Regent Booher, the President of the University was authorized to expend the amount One Hundred dollars bequeathed by the late H. P. Krause for the University Library.

On motion of Regent Booher, seconded by Regent Deal, the recommendation of President Stubbs that Mr. Alexander Wise be appointed as Instructor in University Extension Work at Virginia City at Seventy-Five dollars per month was approved.
