The Chairman of the Board was authorized to advertise for 100 tons Rock Springs coal, 75 cords 4-foot split Pine wood and 60 cords 4-foot split Pine slabs, all to be delivered on University

grounds on or before December 1, 1905.

On motion of Regent Booher, seconded by Regent Starrett, Mr. N.

W. Roff, Mr. Sol Hilp and Mr. W. L. Cox were appointed as audi-

tors to examine the books and accounts of the Experiment Station

for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1905.
