Web Project

Your web project, which you have decided to accept, will be to either (a) provide detailed information about your favorite painter, musical act, or author (poet, comic book artist), in a manner which is complete, yet does not violate the law, (b) is called U and UNLV, and details your relationship to your university.

The following is a list of the characteristics that must be contained in your web page, and the points for each. These are the minimum requirements. Simply putting in a table does not guarantee the total points. Effort is part of the scoring.

1. Text. You must use text with more than one size of heading and some effects such as underline and bold. Your project must involve at least two HTML pages linked together, with text and other content on each. 5 points.
2. Graphics. You must put relevant graphics into your web page. 5 points.
3. Table. You must use a table. 5 points.
4. List. You must use either an ordered or unordered list. 5 points.
5. Javascript. At least one use of javascript is required. 5 points.
6. Page stuff. You must change at least three of the background, text, link and visited link colors from the original. You must do some layout work on your page to make it look nice. Your choices must look good and be readable. 10 points.
7. Links. You must have links to other relevant web sites. 10 points.
8. Creativity. Your creativity will be rewarded. Effort and thought are important parts of the web project. 15 points.

Your web page must be in your school account, and it must be done by hand without the help of web design software. The project is due no later than May 1, and will be turned in by emailing me the URL of the page.
